NOCN Level 5 Award in Asbestos Management for Duty Holder/Appointed Person (D417)

01

Who is the D417 for?

The D417 qualification is intended for:

- Duty holders or appointed persons.
- Providers of duty holder/appointed person services.
- Individuals responsible for writing, developing, or auditing asbestos management plans.

What type of course is the D417?

The D417 is a classroom-based course consisting of 14 modules organized into 5 groups. It includes presentations and quizzes to ensure comprehensive understanding.

What is the D417 course content?

The course covers:

- Legislation & Guidance Documents
- Asbestos Licensing and Contractor Management
- Managing Asbestos in Non-Domestic Premises
- Assessing Asbestos Presence and Risks
- Asbestos Management Plans and Incident Management

How long does the D417 course take?

The course runs for 4 days of teaching followed by a final assessment on the 5th day.

What is the assessment process for the D417?

Assessment involves two exam papers. It is an open-book assessment, designed to reflect real-life scenarios and practical application of knowledge.

Certificates are issued electronically within a week after satisfactory assessment completion.
